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## 1. Introduction

#### 1.1 Document Purpose

This document is a reference guide for using the access role management capabilities of EIMS. This document provides detailed instructions for:

- Logging into the EIMS SailPoint Interface
- Viewing the access roles in your management scope
- Searching for end-users in your management scope
- Modifying the membership of the access roles in your management scope
- Assigning roles to users in your management scope

This document demonstrates how an agency administrator can assign MobileLinc User role to qualified USDA personnel. MobileLinc user role qualifications are, a) the user has a USDA issued mobile device and b) the user has an active LincPass.

#### 1.2 Audience

This document is intended for USDA Agency access role managers. Agency access role managers are responsible for managing the membership of the roles defined in EIMS that are used to access the Agency's applications or systems.

### 1.3 Scope

This document provides information on the access role management capabilities of EIMS only. This document is not a comprehensive guide for all EIMS administrative functionality. This document should be used by those meeting the "Audience" description and is not intended for dissemination to end-users.

## 2. How to Access EIMS

#### 2.1 Access the EIMS User Interface

To access EIMS, go to the following URL: <a href="https://idm.icam.usda.gov/identityiq">https://idm.icam.usda.gov/identityiq</a>. Login using your LincPass PIV credential and PIN.

NOTE: Due to security, access to EIMS with a PIV exemption **is not permitted**. LRAs must have access to a USDA network and or USDA VPN and use their PIV to access EIMS. There are currently no exceptions.




# 3. Role Assignment

### 3.1 Request a New Role Assignment

This section will outline how to view /assign roles within your management scope. This is the preferred task for assigning access roles to a single user.


1. To begin, on the **EIMS Homepage**, select the **Menu**.

2. From the **Menu** dropdown, select the **Manage Access** option.


FIGURE 2: Manage Access Option





3. From the Manage Access dropdown, select the Manage User Access option.

- 4. Once the **Manage User Access** option is selected, you will arrive on the **Manage User Access** page.
- 5. On the Manage User Access page, select the desired user(s) who you like to add the new role(s) for via the Search User field under 1. Select Users chevron tab. Enter the user's name or person GUID into the field and select the magnifying glass search icon. To select a specific user, click on the checkmark on that users record. NOTE: You can also search for users by selecting the Filters option to the right of the Search Users field.

6. After selecting the desired user(s), select the **Next** option at the bottom of the page.


FIGURE 5: Confirm User






7. On the **2. Manage Access** chevron tab, search for the specific role, *OCIO\_MobileLinc\_IT-Support*, request via the **Search Access** field then select the **magnifying glass** search icon. To select the role, click on the **checkmark** on that role assignment record. Then, select **next**.




### 3.1.1 Removing an Existing Role Assignment

This section will outline how an existing user's role assignment can be removed within EIMS. Only Managers and Role Administrators can perform this function.

1. On the **EIMS homepage**, select **Menu**.

2. From the Menu dropdown, select Manage Access option.

FIGURE 10: Manage Access Option




3. From the Manage Access dropdown, select the Manage User Access option.

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4. On the Manager User Access page, select the desired user(s) who you like to add the new role(s) for via the Search User field under 1. Select Users chevron tab. Enter the user's name or person GUID into the field and select the magnifying glass search icon. To select a specific user, click on the checkmark on that users record. NOTE: You can also search for users by selecting the Filters option to the right of the Search Users field.

FIGURE 13: Confirm User




6. On the **2. Manage Access** chevron tab, select the **Remove Access** option. Then, in the **Search** field, type in the user role and click on the **magnifying glass** to search.

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7. To select a specific role, click on the **X** on that role assignment record and click **Next**.
